Port Welshpool & District Maritime Museum

DOORS ARE OPEN; Since the Sea Days Festival 2022 the Museum was closed for much needed renovations. She has been, since she was built during 1881, resting on rocks as were the building regulations back then, but as she started to show her age re-blocking was a must. Having the building empty it also gave the committee a good opportunity to do some spring cleaning.

Built by John Avery of Port Albert, who it is told, walked from Port Albert on a Monday and home again Friday. Hard to believe in this day and age as we see present day tradesmen travelling up and down the highway on a daily basis. John was employed to build this dwelling for W.B.M. Smith and his bride Elizabeth. At the time, the land and house was in William's brother's name, as law as it was then, you had to be of age to be a land holder. William and Elizabeth lived in this home until they died, rearing 5 children all born at home. As it is said sea water ran in the families veins. For the love of the sea was their life, and their home, the now Museum is testimony to that along with their boat the "Janet Iles". Sea creatures of all kinds can be seen on display.

William had them all cured and displayed in glass cases along with shells strung by his daughters to compliment the displays. Part of this collection was once on display in a building in Melbourne to give city folk an idea of what was caught from the sea and to promote the sale of fish. Part of the renovations of the rooms of the building itself was to upgrade the shell room. This collection is very unique to the Museum with an extensive collection of shells of the area many collected by the Smith family. The shells previously housed in shelving, donated to the committee when the house was transferred, from a home to a Museum during the early 70's, and had become in need of an upgrade, so as to give visitors a better view of the collection with lighting to compliment the displays. All the rooms have been given a coat of paint. The floor, well, some unwelcome visitors had decided it was a great place to make their home and they were shown the door. So with the termites gone and the necessary treatment done the floor was replaced where necessary and new floor coverings were laid to replace the well worn ones. All these alterations were done under the careful watch of the committee in line with heritage rules for heritage listed buildings. The committee have worked tirelessly to put all exhibits back in place. With new lighting in all rooms the exhibits are well shown. Many photos have been restored, with a story explaining them, as known. There is always work to be done and many hands make light work, true as it is said. Extra hands are always welcome, as we that are presently involved as volunteers know, being surrounded by this wealth of history, and are always excited to learn new parts of history as it emerges and the important part the Port itself and the surrounding area has played in Victoria's development.

This article is just a small insight into the renovations and history of your asset as it stands proudly waiting for you to visit, come join us, you won't be disappointed. The Museum show cases in part the history of a Port, its people, the fishing industry, education and the sporting clubs to name a few, as I say in part as there is always more to learn and learn we do, from visitors and their donations.

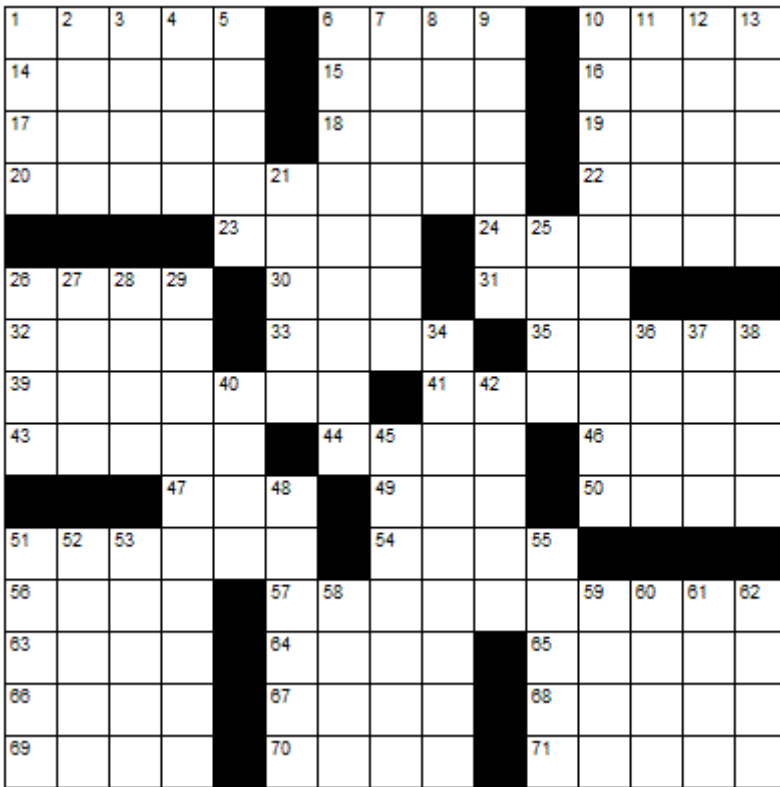

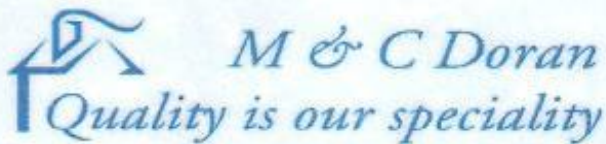

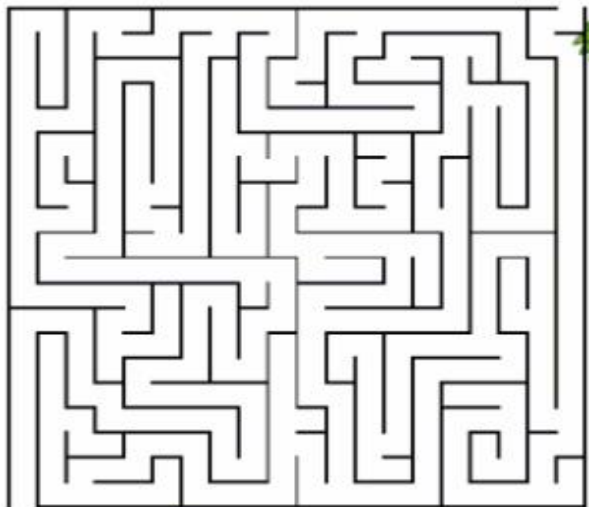
