Community benefits from Bendigo Bank Grants

The Toora & Foster Community Bank Grants Program has wrapped up for 2020, and it is exciting to see funds heading out to contribute to community projects. Since opening in 1999, the Toora & Foster Bendigo Bank Branches have returned more than \$1.22 Million into our community.

The Grants Program received a significant number of applications from organisations seeking funding for projects. The process is administered by Community Enterprise Foundation™, the philanthropic arm of Bendigo and Adelaide Bank.

Robert Liley, Chair of the Board who oversees our local Toora & Foster Bendigo Bank Branches, said, "We were amazed and encouraged by the wide collection of applications received for our 2020 Community Bank Grants Program. "We were very impressed with the quality of applications received, many of which may not have been financially viable without the support of our Community Bank Branch," Rob said

We are hoping to return each Monday throughout Term 3 at 9.30am and will run for approximately two hours. Please let us know if you plan on joining in on the fun!

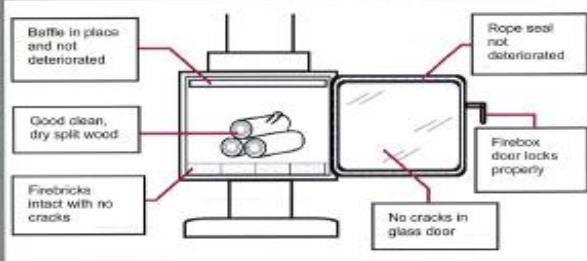

What does your wood heater look like?

The number of chimney fires each year is increasing. Now is the time to check and maintain your fireplace, chimney, firebox and flue to reduce your risk of fire.



- Always use dry wood.
- Always place a screen in front of an open fire.
- Keep clothing and other items a metre from the heater.
- Never leave children unsupervised around fire.
- Have a working smoke alarm.
- Never let a fire burn after you've gone to bed or left the house.
- Ensure chimneys and flues are professionally cleaned annually.
- Ensure ashes are cold before discarding.

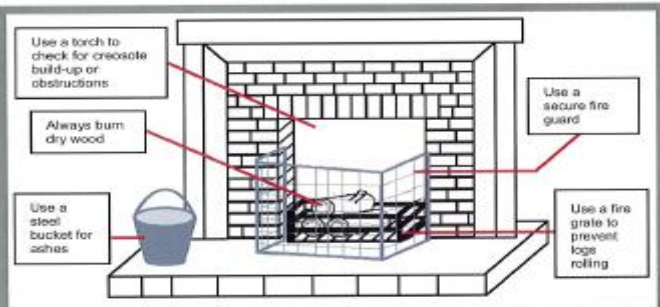


What does your fireplace look like?

The number of chimney fires each year is increasing. Ensuring you are burning the correct fuel will reduce your risk of fire.

Green wood creates more smoke, less flame and less heat. Dry wood burns more efficiently and creates less creosote. Creosote is a black, tar-like residue that is highly flammable and clogs up your chimney. A creosote build-up can cause devastating chimney fires.

Annual professional cleaning and dry wood use will help reduce your risk of fire.



- Always use dry wood.
- Don't throw wrapping paper, boxes, or glossy paper into the fire place.
- Have a working smoke alarm.
- Keep clothing and other items a metre from the heater.
- Never let a fire burn after you've gone to bed or left the house.
- Ensure ashes are cold before discarding.
- Have chimney professionally cleaned annually.
- Never leave children unsupervised around fire.

Quick Chicken Casserole

This quick chicken casserole is so tasty and simple that it'll soon be a regular on your family menu plan.



Ingredients

- 2 tbs olive oil
- 1 kg chicken breast (cut into chunks)
- 2 x 425 g condensed cream of chicken soup
- 1 cup Massel Chicken Style Liquid Stock
- 500 g chunky frozen vegetables
- 1 tbs thyme
- 2 tbs parsley (chopped)

Method

- 1/ Preheat oven to 200 degree celsius (180 degrees celsius fan-forced)
- 2/ In a frypan, heat the olive oil over a medium-high heat and fry the chicken until it is slightly browned on the edges
- 3/ Add the stock, soup and thyme to the chicken and stir. Stir in the frozen vegetables. Bring to the boil and pour into a casserole dish.
- 4/ Bake the mixture in the oven for 45 minutes.
- 5/ Sprinkle with chopped parsley to garnish.

Notes

- A whole bag (1kg) of chunky frozen vegetables with an extra cup of stock works well
- If you have some bacon you can fry it with the chicken

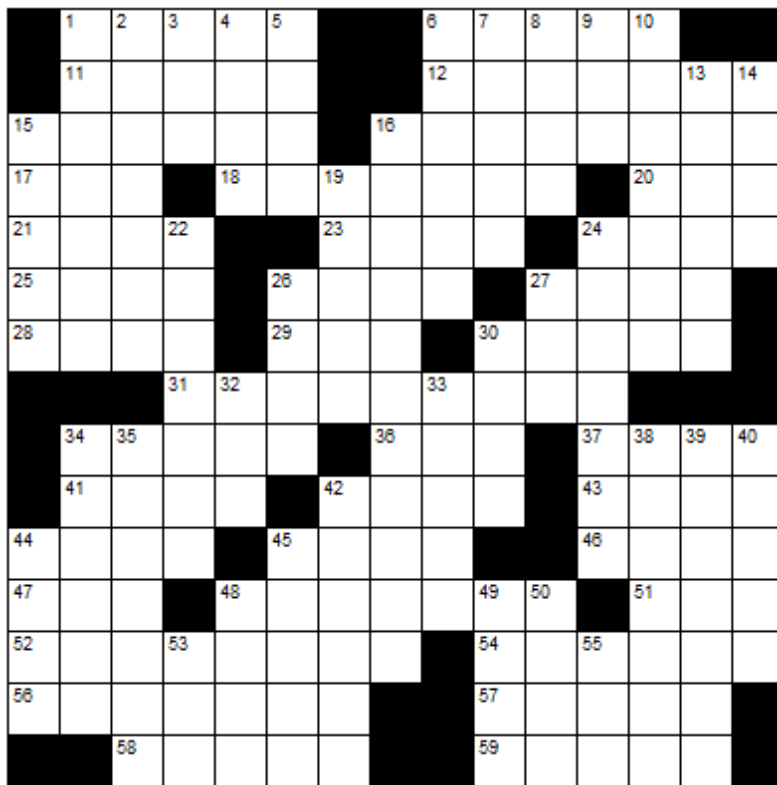

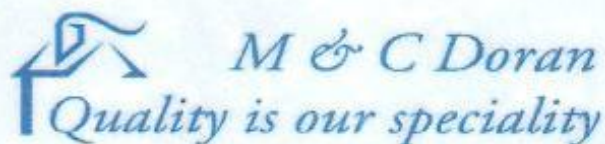
