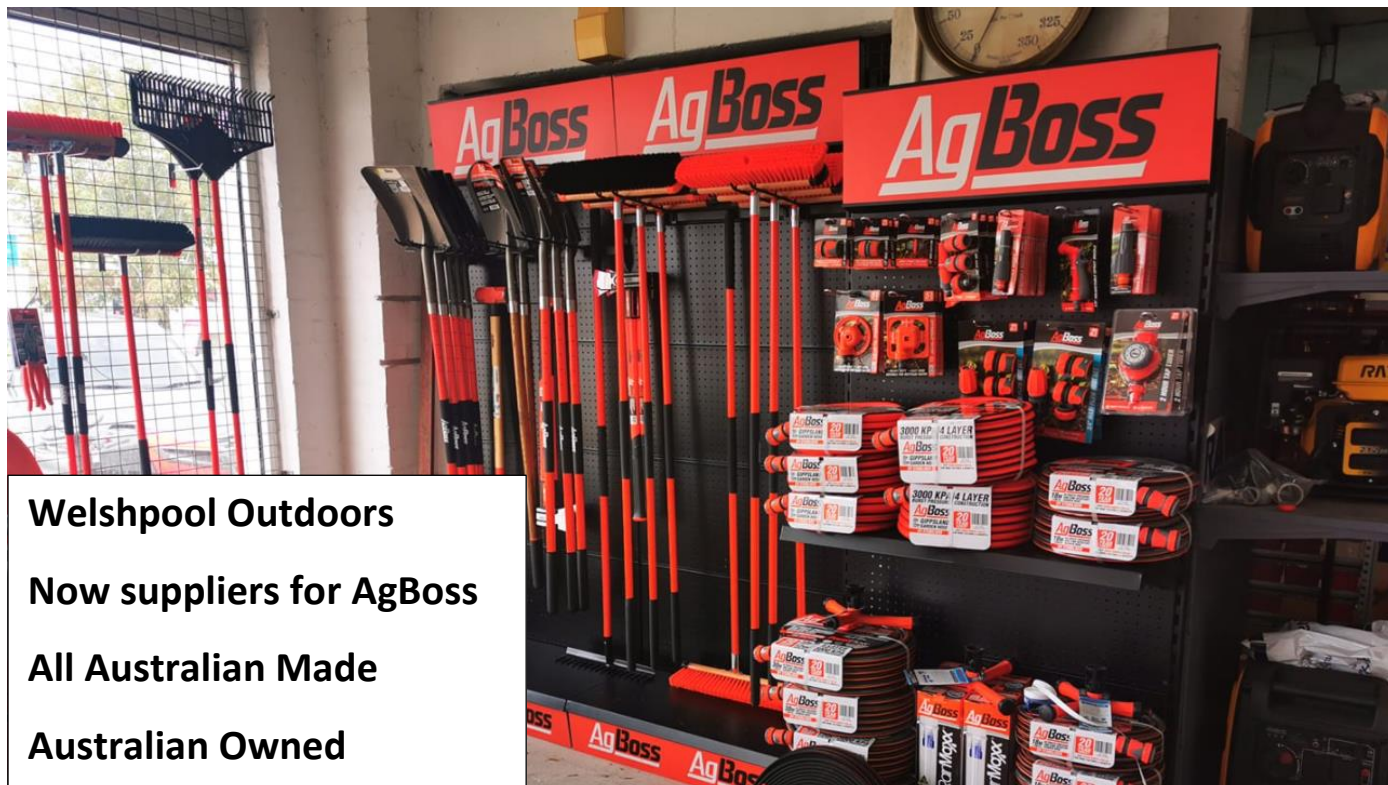

## Port Welshpool and District Maritime Museum

What's happening at the Museum you may ask.....Well, at present we are closed; as you drive, walk or ride along Turnbull Street during the next few weeks you will see this historic house going through a few changes.

For her age she is doing very well but like all of us eventually age catches up with us. So during the coming weeks she is going to have a face lift, with a few nip and tucks she will be literally lifted in to the 21<sup>st</sup> century creaking as she goes in the form of re-blocking Since being built in 1881 she has been resting on blocks of rock as was the norm for building regulations of the times, but over the years, the earth and house had some issues, so modern technology and man power came to the rescue. Nothing major will change as she is heritage listed, other than getting new foundation to spend the next 100 plus years in comfort.

When the re-blocking is finished and with all the rooms empty it is a great opportunity to freshen up the inside with a coat of paint, as soon as this is all completed the doors will be open for business.

Recently we have had some wonderful photos donated from the Corbett family who once call Port Welshpool home. History in the keeping.

Until next issue take care and stay well and here is an easy recipe to enjoy.

This slice has never had an official name other than to me **Easy Slice**.

Line a slice tin with baking paper.

**Oven on moderate, cooking time 25 mins** as you will appreciate ovens may vary but when tested the skewer will come out clean.

### Ingredients:

In a bowl mix one cup of each;

S.R.Flour, Shredded Coconut, Sultanas, chopped dried Apricots and Brown Sugar.

Half a cup of your favourite chopped nuts can be added if liked.

Then add one cup of milk, full cream or skim, your choice doesn't matter.

Stir until well combined. Cook as instructions above.

Please note no butter or eggs.

Turn onto a cake rack to cool.

**To ice;** mix together Icing sugar, a good spoon full of Cheese Spread Cream Cheese, [ from the jar], a slurp of vanilla, and hot water to a consistency of your liking spread on slice and top with more shredded coconut. I prefer shredded but you can use fine.

When icing is dry slice, then boil the jug make a cuppa..... **enjoy**.

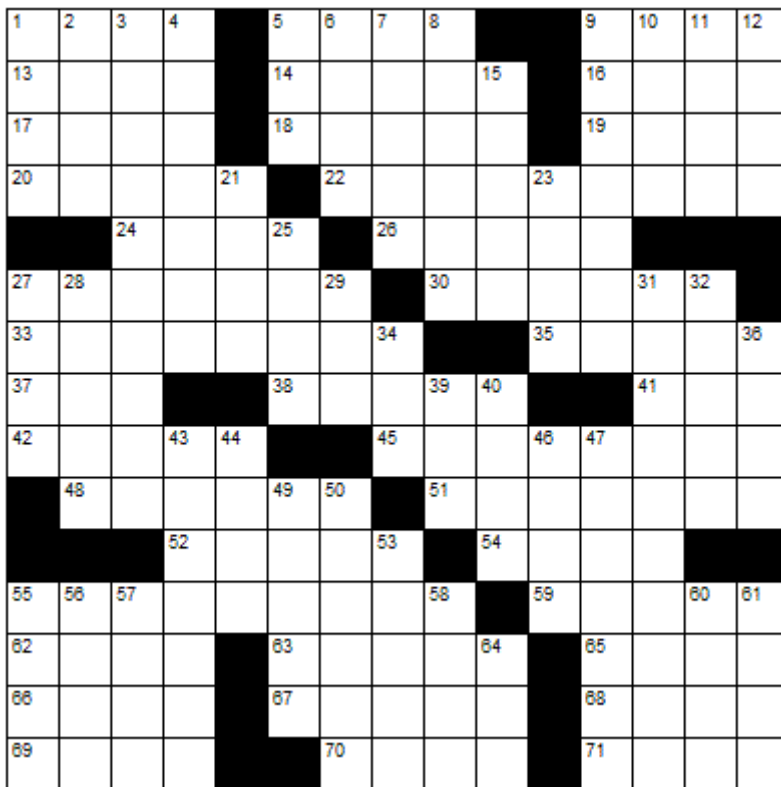

## Welshpool Recreation Reserve

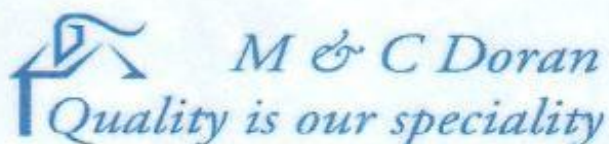
Great to see our community Recreation Reserve being used for a variety of activities. Last week we had another chopper stopping in with a delivery from Deal Island, fuelling up before heading back.

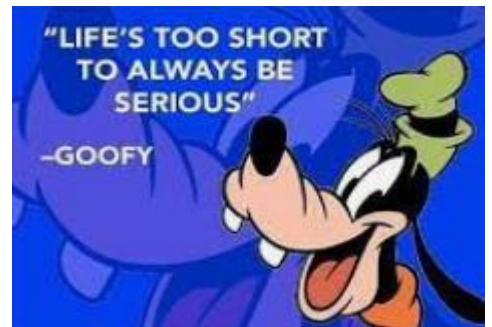
